

Geography

The primary teachers in grades K-2 of Egyptian School District in Illinois selected ten different locations for each grade level to locate on a globe. Each student 1:1, eight times per year will be asked to locate the ten locations for their grade level. In addition the first grade students will be asked to locate two of the kindergarten locations (randomly selected). The second grade students will be asked to locate 14 locations – their ten grade level locations plus two kindergarten and two first grade.

The graphs that follow are student and class run charts for geography. Students will be assessed every month except August and December. The choice of locations was a combination of local and general knowledge. An example of local for them is two neighboring states of Kentucky and Missouri plus their home state of Illinois. The Mississippi and Ohio Rivers are also on their lists. Examples of general knowledge are North Pole, continents, some countries and the equator.
